

STATEWIDE AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION  
(CCPOA)  
AND  
THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA,  
DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION (CDCR)  
AND  
DIVISION OF ADULT PAROLE OPERATIONS (DAPO)  
REGARDING THE  
IMPLEMENTATION OF ALTERNATIVE CUSTODY PROGRAM (ACP)


This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of Meet and Confer negotiations on October 12, 2011, regarding the Implementation of the Alternative Custody Program (ACP). This Agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit Six Memorandum of Understanding.


1. The State agrees that EID policy shall be followed for the duration of ACP.
2. The State and CCPOA agree that ANT results shall be recorded on the ROS in accordance with existing Division of Adult Parole Operations (DAPO) policy.
3. Page 59 of the ACP Program Guide, Bullet No. 3 will have the two (2) references "shall" will be changed to "may".
4. The State acknowledges that the ACP Guide dated July, 2011 will be corrected on Page 89, Section B, to remove direction that Initial Home Contact will be done on the first business day after transfer to ACP.
5. The State and CCPOA agree that the term "5 days" actually means 5 "working days".
6. The State acknowledges that no Correctional Counselor I (CC-I) will be required to act as Institutional Classification Committee (ICC) Recorder for the ACP unless they are in a documented and approved Out-of-Class assignment.
7. The State acknowledges that in the Program Regulations for the ACP, the reference to CC-II is actually a CC-II Supervisor and *not* a CC-II Specialist.

- 8. The State and CCPOA agree that inmate screening will be in compliance with the ACP screening process.
- 9. The State and CCPOA agree that if an inmate has permanent exclusions, the CC-I will not be required to re-screen the inmate during the current term.
