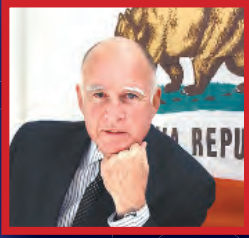

In August, a panel of federal judges found the prison system was so overcrowded they ordered the release of over 40,000 inmates within two years.¹

California's recidivism rate is already 70 percent, the nation's highest.²
