**Re: Statewide Agreement – Realignment & Post Release Community Supervision for Correctional Counselors**

Please see attached agreement on Realignment & Post Release Community Supervision for Correctional Counselors. This negotiated agreement regarding “Implementation and Training on PC 3450 Post Release Community Release Supervision” now becomes an addendum to the Bargaining Unit 6 Memorandum Of Understanding.

STATEWIDE AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
CALIFORNIA CORRECTIONAL PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION (CCPOA)

THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA,  
DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION (CDCR)  
REGARDING THE  
IMPLEMENTATION AND TRAINING OF PENAL CODE SECTION 3450 - REALIGNMENT  
AND POST RELEASE COMMUNITY SUPERVISION  
FOR CORRECTIONAL COUNSELORS

This Agreement represents the full and complete understanding reached by and between the parties at the conclusion of Meet and Confer negotiations on September 16, 2011, regarding the Implementation and Training on PC 3450 Post Release Community Supervision. This Agreement becomes an addendum to the current State Bargaining Unit Six Memorandum of Understanding.

1. The CDCR acknowledges that caseload carrying BU6 CCI's shall not be delegated procedures outlined in Attachment "D", Page 4 and 5, addressing MDO/SVP procedures for the memorandum dated July 28, 2011, titled *Public Safety Realignment Implementation Memorandum No. 1 - Post Release Community Supervision*, at institutions that have funded Sexually Violent Predator Program BU6 CCI's.
2. The CDCR acknowledges that ration driven caseload carrying BU6 CCI's shall be provided the central file for inmates who are releasing to Postrelease Community Supervision who have an imminent or overdue release date for completion of the CDCR Form 611 and CDCR Form 1515-CS. The Ratio-driven caseload carrying BU6 CCI shall have two (2) business days to complete the process and inmate notification from the date the file is received, unless extenuating circumstances exist.
3. The State acknowledges that the workload in the memorandum dated July 28, 2011, titled *Public Safety Realignment Implementation Memorandum No. 1 - Post Release Community Supervision*, and the memorandum dated August 26, 2011, titled *Public Safety Realignment Implementation Memorandum No. 2 - Post Release Community Supervision*, assigned to the Parole Planning and Placement Team, Case Records staff, and the Classification & Parole Representative shall not be delegated to Ration-driven case load carrying BU6 CCI's.
4. The State acknowledges that the workload in the memorandum dated July 28, 2011, titled *Public Safety Realignment Implementation Memorandum No. 1 - Post Release Community Supervision*, and the memorandum dated August 26, 2011, titled *Public Safety Realignment Implementation Memorandum No. 2 - Post Release Community Supervision*, assigned to the Correctional Counselor II Supervisor shall not be delegated to Ration-driven case load carrying BU6 CCI's unless they are performing the duties of a supervising CCII in a documented acting assignment.
5. The State acknowledges that the time frame associated with the issuance of Special Conditions of Release for PRCS shall be the same as those that currently exist for the issuance of Special Conditions of Parole (SCOP) for Division of Adult Parole Operations (DAPO).
6. The State acknowledges that while rescreening previously screened inmates, when an inmate is determined to be eligible for parole the BU6 CCI's do not need to re-do the CDCR Form 1515, unless one has not been previously completed or special conditions are requested.

7. The CDCR acknowledges that the PC 3000 exclusion box on the CDCR Form 611 (Revised 08/2011) only applies to inmates who have both an active parole period and a new commitment.
8. The State agrees that BU6 CCI's will be given two (2) copies of PRCS Special Conditions of Parole to serve to the inmate.
