This notice is regarding the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR), Division of Adult Institutions' (DAI) intent, as a result of the realignment of inmates, convert 760 Facility B Level IV General Population Beds to 700 Level IV Enhanced Out Patient (EOP) Sensitive Needs Yard (SNY) Beds and convert 150 Facility B Level IV EOP Beds to 150 Level IV EOP SNY Beds at the California State Prison, Corcoran effective February 2012.

RE: PUBLIC SAFETY REALIGNMENT ACT (AB 109) INSTITUTION CONVERSION --
CALIFORNIA STATE PRISON CORCORAN (CDCR LOG #11-176-0)

Dear Mr. Weiss:

As you know, and has been discussed with the California Correctional Peace Officers Association (CCPOA), changes consistent with AB 109 and related legislation have begun rolling out and Rehabilitation (CDCR) will be sending you notices of such changes consistent with the parties' Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). It is our hope and intent that the parties will continue to have significant communication during the roll-out of the changes.

The purpose of this realignment notice is to inform CCPOA that effective February 2012, CDCR Division of Adult Institutions (DAI) will, as a result of the realignment of inmates at California State Prison- Corcoran (COR), convert 760 Facility "B" level IV General Population (GP) Beds to 700 Level IV Enhanced Out Patient (EOP) Sensitive Needs Yard (SNY) Beds and convert 150 Facility "B" Level IV EOP Beds to 150 Level IV EOP SNY Beds. These conversions may result in a reduction of staff.

We are currently assembling documents and information relevant to this notice (e.g. Post Orders, revised Operational Procedures, Staffing Packages and etc.) and will provide these documents to CCPOA once they are complete. We, however, did not want to delay sending this notice to CCPOA.

If you believe this conversion creates impact to Bargaining Unit (BU) 6 members within the scope of bargaining and wish to meet, please have your assigned staff person contact Dolores Slaton, Labor Relations Manager, by phone at 916-323-3709 or by email at Dolores.Slaton@cdcr.ca.gov within ten (10) days of the date of this notice to meet prior to implementation.

If you have questions or wish to discuss the foregoing, please do not hesitate to contact me. In addition, if you are aware of information or documents that you or your team may want to see, please let us know at your earliest convenience so that we can start preparing. As always, it
