

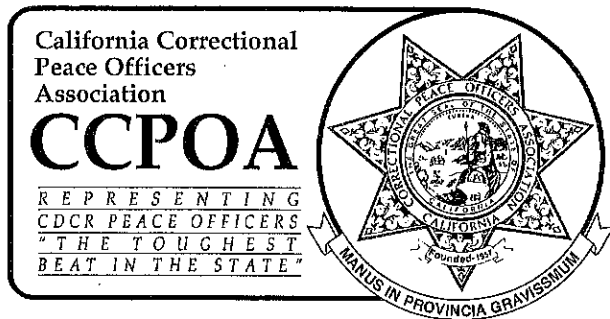

Dear Mr. Weiss:

Effective October 23, 2011, the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitations (CDCR), Division of Juvenile Justice, (DJJ) will be relocate its Southern Youth Correctional Reception Center-Clinic (SYCRCC) Intake/Pre-Morrissey Unit located at 13200 South Bloomfield Avenue, Norwalk, California to the Ventura Youth Correctional Facility located at 3100 Wright Road, Camarillo, California.

The youth at the Ventura Youth Correctional Facility (VYCF) are housed within the perimeter security fence of the VYCF compound. The program is in a secure single story building and contains 43 single bunked rooms. The rooms are separated by a control center and dayroom. Group meeting rooms and staff offices are located in the building.

The VYCF facility is enclosed within a 14-foot perimeter security fence, enhanced with two feet of barbed wire and razor ripper wire.

The Pre-Morrissey Program consists of juvenile offenders who are on parole supervision and have failed to adhere to their conditions of parole out in the community while on parole or have picked up another charge, thus violating a condition of parole. The program focus is to assist and educate parolees going through the revocation process. The juvenile offender will develop a basic understanding of the parole revocation process which includes notification date time frames in receiving a notice of charges, meeting with an assigned CALPAP attorney, scheduling of a probable cause hearing to a full revocation hearing including ones ability to appeal the hearing decision. The Program is also intended to provide parolees with realistic expectations about parole, discussion of



their experiences within the community while out on parole and opportunities to take responsibility for the various aspects of their daily lives.

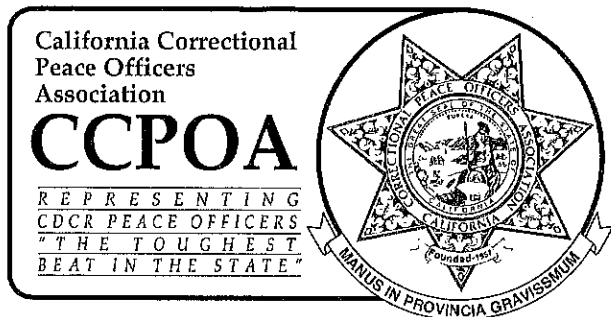
The Pre-Morrissey Program prepares parolees to go through the Parole Revocation Process. If they arrive at the facility revoked, the revoked offender's treatment needs and current risks are considered in requesting an appropriate placement for the revoked offender to complete their violation time prior to transitioning back into the community. The staff will work collaboratively with affected parolees, their Field Parole Agents, and the Board Coordinating Parole Agent in the monitoring and coordinating of required documents between departments for the Revocation process. The Treatment Team ensures an appropriate level of care is provided to the parolees so that they may successfully go through the Revocation Process.

Subject: **EMERGENCY REVISION OF OCTOBER 2011 INSTITUTION ACTIVATION SCHEDULE AND ISSUANCE OF NOVEMBER 2011 INSTITUTION ACTIVATION SCHEDULE**

An Emergency Revision to the October 2011 Institution Activation Schedule (IAS) and issuance of the November 2011 IAS is attached. This notice supersedes activations or deactivations planned in the Assembly Bill (AB) 109 IAS.

The following emergency revisions to the IAS have been scheduled for October 2011:


- Central California Women's Facility will postpone until November 2011, the deactivation of 77 female beds in Facility C.
- California Institution for Women will deactivate 44 female beds in the Reception Center, reducing the Reception Center to 150 percent overcrowding.

The following change has been made to the IAS for November 2011 subsequent to the AB 109 IAS:

- Substance Abuse Treatment Facility will deactivate 120 Level III Sensitive Needs Yard beds in Facility D Gym.

For budget planning purposes, institutions are asked to submit staffing packages and 607s for activations and deactivations listed in this memorandum, but not previously approved, to the Program Support Unit (PSU) for review and approval by **Friday, October 7, 2011**. 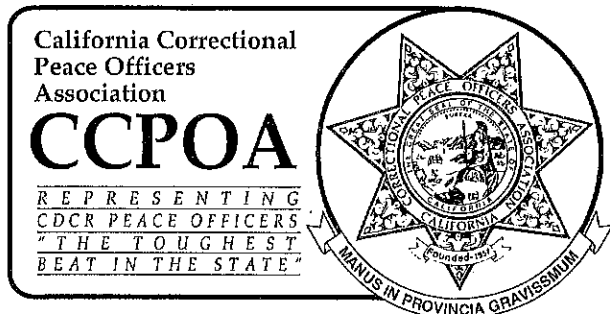

As has been discussed with the California Correctional Peace Officer Association (CCPOA), changes consistent with AB 109 and related legislation (Realignment) are going to start rolling out soon. As we have also discussed, the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) will be sending you notices of such changes consistent with the parties' Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). It is our hope and intent that the parties will continue to have significant communication during the roll-out of the changes.

The purpose of this Realignment notice is to inform CCPOA that effective December 2011, CDCR Division of Adult Institutions (DAI) will, as a result of the Realignment of inmates, convert the reception beds at North Kern State Prison. The conversion of 760 reception beds to 600 Level III GP beds (Facility A, buildings 2, 3, 4 & 5) may result in a reduction of staff associated with the conversion.

We are currently assembling documents and information relevant to this notice (e.g. Post Orders, revised Operational Procedures, Staffing Packages and etc.) and will provide these documents to CCPOA once they are complete. We, however, did not want to delay sending this notice to CCPOA.

The Division of Adult Parole Operations (DAPO) intends to discontinue the pilot for the attached California Parole Supervision and Reintegration Model (CPSRM) and begin implementing on October 23, 2011, the CPSRM on a statewide basis, effectively reducing the established Parole Agent (PA) workload from a Parolee to PA ratio of 70 to 1 to a new ratio of 53 to 1.

The CPSRM has been utilized for approximately 11 months as a pilot program in 4 pilot units located throughout the State. During the pilot, several modifications to the policy were deemed necessary to make the processes contained within the CPSRM more efficient, including the elimination of duplicative efforts and unnecessary work. This overall reduction in workload for the PAs is being utilized to accommodate the increase in parolees per caseload from the current 48 to 53. The changes to the policy include the following:


- Modified language to reflect the new ratio of 53 to 1 for PA Is.
- Modified language to reflect the new ratio of 13 to 1 for PA IIs.
- Added language to delineate the differences between a PA II Specialist and a PA II Supervisor.
- Added language to include the PA II Supervisor with the Unit Supervisor in the area of duties that cannot be delegated to a non-supervisor.
- Added language to specify that PAs will create Case Plans in the Correctional Offender Management Profiling for Alternative Sanctions (COMPAS) database for Court Walkover cases within 45 calendar days of their parole date.
- Added language to specify that the COMPAS Case Plan will be updated on a monthly basis for parolees who are referred to a service, successfully complete a program or service, or fail to complete an assigned program or service.
- Added language to show that the Unit Supervisor and PA "verify" that the COMPAS reports are in the field file instead of "printing" the reports.
- Revised the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) Form 1658 (Rev. 06/11), Parolee Residence/Employment Verification, to remove questions included in other forms and to include a property diagram.
- Added language that the Officer of the Day will also review the COMPAS Case Plan with the offender during Initial Interviews.
- Modified language for inmates who are to be transferred closer to their county of commitment from "Determinate or Indeterminate" to "endorsed for Security Housing Unit or Psychiatric Services Unit terms."

- Removed language that stated the CDCR Form 611 (Rev. 10/06), Release Program Study, could only be used for parolees initially released from a CDCR institution or facility.
- Modified language so that all category changes become effective immediately.
- Added language that when a category changes on or prior to the 20th of the month, the PA utilizes the new category contact specifications, and if the change occurs after the 20th of the month then the PA is accountable for the old category specifications.
- Modified language to change the length of the Transition Phase from 60 days to 90 days.
- Modified language to allow for Civil Addict Commitments to be placed into Category B.
- Added language that offenders in community-based In-Custody Drug Treatment Programs (ICDTP) should be placed into Category C.
- Added language that offenders in jail-based ICDTP should be placed into Category D.
- Modified the language for the CDCR Form 1661 (Rev. 06/10), Monthly Goals/Progress Report, from the PAs may issue them to offenders, to PAs shall issue them to offenders on a calendar quarterly basis with the exception of Category D cases and Enhanced Outpatient Clinic cases that are unable to participate in the process.
- Added language that PA will note on the CDCR Form 1661 if a parolee refuses to participate in the goals and progress report process.
- Added language that created an Abbreviated Case Conference Review process for when a Parole Agent is recommending a decrease in the supervision category after the offender is already out of the Transition Phase. This abbreviated process no longer requires the parolee to be invited to the Case Conference Review (CCR) for the abbreviated process if it is not deemed necessary by the Agent of Record or Unit Supervisor.
- Added language that the annual CCR will be conducted within 60 calendar days.
- Added language that the notification of the CCR to the parolee may be in writing.
- Discontinued use of the CDCR Form 1502CM, Category Movement Sheet, and created the CDCR Form 1657 (Rev. 07/11), Case Conference Review/Discharge Consideration Committee.
- Merged the CDCR Form 1650-B (Rev. 06/10), Initial Interview, and the CDCR Form 1650B-1 (Rev. 06/10), Comprehensive Interview, into one form, the CDCR Form 1650-B (Rev. 06/11), Initial/Comprehensive Interview, to remove duplicate entry of fields and questions.
- Added line to the CDCR Form 1650-B with yes and no boxes, for the PA to indicate if they have explained the COMPAS Case Plan to the offender.
- Added language that the first CDCR Form 1661 will be issued within 15 working days of release.
- Added language to provide examples of resource collateral.
- Added language to stipulate that the language used on the CDCR Form 1650-D (Rev. 07/10), Record of Supervision, must be clear enough to determine what type of search was conducted at the residence during a home visit.
- Added language that gives the Unit Supervisor the ability to place an offender back into the Transition Phase for up to the full 90 calendar days if there was a break in supervision while the offender was being supervised in the Transition Phase.
- Modified the CDCR Form 1502-DR (Rev. 07/11), Discharge Review Report, to capture more information and to incorporate more check boxes to ease the completion of this form.
- Removed language that stated the workload of PAs is balanced and adjusted on a daily basis if required.
- Added language to exempt homeless shelters, emergency housing and other approved exemptions as determined by the Unit Supervisor or designee from requiring a CDCR Form 1658 to be completed if the offender moves into one of those locations.
- Modified the CDCR Form 1650-D to provide more space for writing and more abbreviation codes to utilize in the work type columns.
- Added language for Court Walkovers that a copy of the court paperwork may be required to calculate a manual California Static Risk Assessment Score if the current commitment does not appear on the criminal history.
- Added language that offenders are eligible to receive rewards or incentives if they display four positive behaviors and display no negative behavior.

- Added language that a Discharge Consideration Committee (DCC) may be held at a physical location within the Parole District or done via teleconference.
- Removed language that stated the District Administrator was required to attend the DCC.
- Added language that the PA will review the Disability and Effective Communications database prior to a CCR or DCC and to serve as a staff assistant if accommodations are required.
- Added language that the District Administrator will complete a checkbox on the CDCR Form 1502-DR indicating if a case is eligible for a DCC.
- Added language to outline the steps for a DCC.
- Added language that the Parole Unit support staff will fax as well as mail the results of the DCC as noted on the BPT Form 1130, Central Office Calendar, to Case Records if the DCC is held at the Parole Unit.
- Added language to list the Non-Revocable Parole Units as one of the exceptions where cases may be carried in Cal Parole under the PA III.
- Modified language under the parolee-at-large referrals to the California Parolee Apprehension Teams section to reflect the 2011 policy changes to this process.
- Created separate job duty statements for PA II Supervisors and PA II Specialists to delineate the differences in classification and job duties.
- Added language to request a manual California Static Risk Assessment (CSRA) score when the current CSRA score shows as being auto-calculated and the criminal history indicates out-of-state convictions.
